



Fairmeadows TV Guidelines

Lifeguards have authority in any dispute among members involving the TVs.

Members are free to change the channels on the TVs, keeping in mind that the TVs are for the entertainment of adults.

Children or kids under 18 should not operate the TVs at any time.

The general principle of operating the TVs should be the reasonable person standard; reasonable volume as to not compete with the pool music (falling under the amplified sound pool rule); *reasonable content that you would see at a sports bar; reasonable conduct around changing channels.

Fairmeadows does not have the resources nor the desire to closely monitor operation of the TVs, so we are relying on the membership to operate them reasonably.

TVs should not be used for the entertainment of children at any time.

The TVs do not have to be on the same channel, but the volume should be so low that you cannot hear both at the same time.

If the TVs are not on, members can request a remote from the lifeguards and choose the channel they want to watch (*see reasonable content note).
